In planning and conducting any activity in the name of **Transition Bro Gwaun**, its members and supporters aim to:

- 1: Strive to minimise the adverse impact of their activities on the environment wherever possible, and look for opportunities to make a positive impact, in accordance with our overall aims and objectives.
- 2: To be guided by the Permaculture principles of Earth Care, People Care and Fair Shares, in accordance with our overall aims and objectives.
- 3: Aim to promote all aspects of environmental awareness amongst its members, supporters and the wider community.
- 4: Be aware of and abide by all relevant environmental legislation.
- 5: Act responsibly with regards to the consumption and disposal of physical resources, particularly those of water and energy. Re-use or recycle materials, where possible, and use the least environmentally damaging products.
- 6: Encourage car sharing, active transport and the use of public transport as an alternative to car journeys.

To ensure that this policy is adhered to as fully as possible, the management committee of **Transition Bro Gwaun** will aim to:

- 1: Review its activities on a regular basis in order to monitor compliance with this policy, and rectify any breaches.
- 2: Review the policy every 3 years at least to take into account changes in environmental legislation or in the activity of the Group.
